Organization/Agency Trainer Requirements

Successful completion of a 3-day Nurturing Program Facilitator Training conducted by a *Recognized Lead National Trainer/Consultant* followed by:

- Minimum three years' experience as facilitator and experience facilitating at least two Nurturing Parenting Programs® as written for the complete number of sessions (Full Fidelity).
- Expertise in the philosophy and goals of Nurturing Program as demonstrated by successful group or home-based implementation of the programs.
- Expertise in and administration of the Adult-Adolescent Parenting Inventory (AAPI-2) and other assessments and inventories of the Nurturing Programs.
- A letter from your supervisor attesting to your success as a trainer within your designated agency and attesting to your facilitation of the listed NPP Curricula.

Participants will meet virtually for 5 hours a day, 9am-11:30am & 1:30pm-4pm, plus 1 hrs. of outside reading per day. Hours of CEU's will be provided. 15 hours will be through direct training (virtual or in-person) and there will be an added 3 hours of outside reading to meet certification requirements (18 total hours). For the full virtual NP training experience, it is encouraged to have with you the current NP curriculum/program you are using.
